How did Ed Johnson get his name? Michael tried to find out, but so far this remains a mystery. Ed Johnson was bred in Louisiana and raced on the Northern California circuit. Owned by Frankfurt Stable and trained by Steven Specht, he won three of his seven starts. As a juvenile he broke his maiden at Golden Gate Fields running wire-to-wire, ridden by Russel Baze. At three he used similar speed to win again Golden Gate Fields with Manuel Cheves up, then in the best effort of his career he took the Alcatraz Stakes at Golden Gate Fields leading from start to finish teamed up again with Russell Baze. In the Robert Dupret Derby at Santa Rosa he was just caught at the wire for a game second. Ed Johnson's career earnings total \$91,355. Old Friends thanks his former owners for enabling the handsome gray's retirement to our farm, which was once home to Prized, his Breeders' Cup Turf winning great-grandfather.
