Bred by John D. Gunther, breeder of 2018 Triple Crown winner Justify, Eye of the Tiger is a multiple graded stakes winner and Kentucky Derby contender. A grandson of Cure the Blues and Phone Trick, Eye of the Tiger raced as a homebred. He went into training with Jerry Hollendorfer and won the first of his two juvenile races. At three he ran second in Keeneland's Lexington Stakes despite a difficult trip and in the 2003 Kentucky Derby he beat most of the field, finishing fifth to winner Funny Cide. That June he won the Affirmed Handicap (G3) at 1 1/16 mile on the dirt at Hollywood Park, ridden by Alex Solis. At four, now trained by Kiaran McLaughlin and honed by a year of stakes campaigning, Eye of the Tiger won the Washington Park Handicap (G2) at 1 3/16 mile on the dirt track at Arlington Park with Eusebio Razo, Jr. in the irons. He retired in 2004 with \$535,679 earnings in 19 races with 5 wins, 2 seconds and 4 thirds. At stud at the Gunthers' Glennwood Farm in Kentucky until 2016, he was retired to Old Friends in 2018. Old Friends warmly thanks the Gunthers for entrusting us with Eye of the Tiger's care.
