2013 dkb G Archarcharch – Two Dot Slew (Evansville Slew)



Bred on Buck Pond Farm in Kentucky, Next Shares matured at age five into a formidable turf competitor for trainer Richard Baltas. His first black type win was the 2018 Old Friends Stakes at Kentucky Downs ridden by Drayden Van Dyke. In his next start, the prestigious Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland, he scored a Grade 1 win with jockey Tyler Gaffalione, then participated in the 2018 Breeders' Cup Mile. At six, Next Shares won the San Gabriel Stakes (G2) at Santa Anita with Geovanni Franco up, and the Seabiscuit Handicap (G2) at Del Mar under Jose Valdivia, Jr. He remained formidable at stakes level until his retirement in the summer of 2021. Next Shares earned a total \$1,891,971 for his owning partnership, Debby Baltas, Richard Baltas, Julia C. Iavarone, Michael Iavarone, Jerry McClanahan, Jeremy Peskoff, Ritchie Robershaw and Mark Taylor, in 41 starts with 7 wins, 5 seconds and 5 thirds. By winning the Old Friends Stakes, Next Shares guaranteed his retirement at Old Friends, which thanks trainer Richard Baltas and all the owning partnership for looking to their equine athlete's future security while the horse was still in mid-career.
