Irish bred Rathor raced as a 3 year old in England with two wins. He debuted in the US at 4 with three wins on the dirt at Aqueduct and Belmont for owners Flaxman Holdings, Ltd. and Hall of Fame trainer Bobby Frankel, with jockey Eibar Coa. Attempts at graded stakes were not successful. At age 5 he won at Keeneland over a field that included 2003 Kentucky Derby winner Funny Cide. Kent Desormeaux was in the irons. Thereafter Rathor was winless until he became a claimer Philadelphia Park. He continued to race at that track (which became Parx Racing), earning for various connections until at age 9 Rathor himself said “enough is enough” by refusing to leave the starting gate. An attempt to retrain him as a saddle horse met with a similarly firm veto from the dark bay gelding. Rathor wanted to retire. He got his wish thanks to Elaine Pelino, Laurie Tuozzolo, Matthew Clarke, and Lorita Lindemann, with transportation to Old Friends in Georgetown courtesy of JR Hudson Horse Transportation. Rathor has let us know that this lifestyle, eating hay, hanging out with his paddock buddies and munching carrots, meets his approval. He has certainly earned it.
