2009 dkb G, Political Force – What a Knight (Tough Knight)



Right to Vote, great-grandson to Old Friends resident Glitterman (1985-2011), was bred in Kentucky by Gulf Coast Farms LLC and Pollock Farms. The tall, dark bay gelding began his race career at two, owned by Casner Racing and trained by Eoin Harty. In his three juvenile starts he was never off the board and he finished third in the prestigious Champagne Stakes (G1). At three he ran second in the Peter Pan Stakes (G2). At four, in the ownership of B J D Thoroughbreds and trained by Ron Moquett, he won the 2013 Kelly's Landing Stakes run at Churchill Downs and named for the best son of Old Friends retiree Patton (1991-2014). Shaun Bridgmohan rode. Right to Vote's five-year-old campaign included victories in the Essex Handicap at Oaklawn Park with Ricardo Santana, Jr. up, and the Jim Rasmussen Memorial Stakes at Prairie Meadows with Israel Ocampo in the irons. He also scored a graded stakes second in the Cornhusker Handicap (G3). He retired in 2016 with \$516,249 earnings from 26 starts, 7 wins, 4 seconds and 5 thirds. Some years later, Right to Vote ended up in endangered circumstances. His former trainer, Ron Moquett, heard of his situation and stepped in to ensure his wellbeing.
