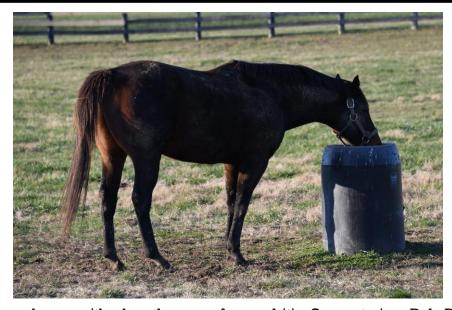

Silver Max

Silver Max's career began with a lengthy case of second-itis. Owner-trainer Dale Romans tried the talented colt with different jockeys until Javier Castellano took him to the winner's circle in his sixth start for new owner Mark Bacon. Romans continued to train. At three, owned by Mark Bacon and Dana Wells, Silver Max tried the dirt in the Holy Bull, a Derby prep, but a first finish off the board prompted a return to the turf for the Transylvania S (G3). He won handily, then won the American Turf S (G2), Arlington Classic, set a track record in the Oliver Stakes, and won the Virginia Derby (G2), a six-race win streak where five were stakes. At four he won the Opening Verse S, Oceanport S (G3), and Bernard Baruch H (G2). That fall he was tested on the dirt again when a downpour moved the 2013 Shadwell Mile (G1) off the Keeneland turf. Silver Max more than met the challenge, becoming the only horse after 2012 to beat Wise Dan. Robby Alberado rode. At five, Silver Max won the Firecracker S (G2), again with Alberado. In 27 starts he won 12, finished second in 5, and third in 1 with \$1,954,738 earnings. He stood at Adena Springs 2015-2020.
